



Britain is Troubled by Hizb ut Tahrir

The news of the ban on Hizb ut Tahrir in Britain has sparked widespread debate and discussion on social media, as well as in English and Arabic-language newspapers, considering it a terrorist group for inciting armies to revolt against their rulers and supporting their brethren in Gaza.

Comment:

Britain realizes that no state has endured like the Islamic state did; it was a Khilafah (Caliphate) and a mercy, for 13 centuries, it carried the message of Islam and spread it to the corners of the earth. It implemented Islam, thus creating the greatest civilization known to history, developing the land, advancing sciences, and leading people from darkness to light; from the oppression of tyrants, empires, and kings to the justice of Islam and its Khulafaa' (Caliphs). It did not force people into Islam; adherents of other religions were considered *Ahl Dhimma* (protected citizens), bound by the covenant of Allah and the protection of His Messenger. Hizb ut Tahrir, with its intellectual and political dawah based on a sound Aqeedah, has engaged in a conscious call suitable for leading humanity to salvation from the evils of capitalism. Undoubtedly, the Hizb's successful involvement in political action on the ground has accumulated political experience, making it effective in its work.
