The United Arab Emirates (UAE) is pressuring the Trump administration to scrap the post-war plan for Gaza

The Middle East Eye (MEE) reported on 17 March that, "The UAE is lobbying the Trump administration to torpedo a post-war plan for the Gaza Strip that Egypt drafted and which has been endorsed by the Arab League, US and Egyptian officials told Middle East Eye."

The Middle East Eye further said, "It reflects growing Arab competition over who calls the shots in the Gaza Strip's future governance and reconstruction, as well as different opinions over how much influence Hamas should retain there."

It stated that "The Emirati pressure poses a dilemma for Cairo because both the UAE and Egypt broadly back the same Palestinian powerbroker for Gaza, Mohammed Dahlan, an exiled former Fatah official." The MEE added, ""The UAE could not be the lone state opposing the Arab League plan when it was agreed, but they are trashing it with the Trump administration." the US official told MEE.""

MEE opined, "The UAE is flexing its unparalleled access to the White House to criticise the plan as unworkable and accuse Cairo of giving too much influence to Hamas. The UAE's powerful ambassador to the US, Yousef al-Otaiba, has been lobbying US President Donald Trump's inner circle and US lawmakers to put pressure on Egypt to accept forcibly displaced Palestinians, one US official and one Egyptian briefed on the matter told MEE."

The Profound Psychological effects of the war on Gaza by the Jews, on the soldiers of the occupation

The discovery of the conference "Psychological Prohibition" held by the 'Israel' Trauma Coalition on "worrying" data showing the deep psychological effects of the war on the army of the Jews. According to the data presented during the conference, the number of people visiting mental health centers increased fourfold, while the activities of these centers increased tenfold.

Afihay Hayim, the social affairs and health correspondent on the website of Walla 'Israeli' news, wrote that mental health centers have become a key element in the "Israeli" health system, especially with the increase in security incidents and the continuation of fighting, which requires the expansion of services and the strengthening of manpower in this area.

According to the official of the 'Israel' Trauma Coalition, Karen Kabitka Huberman, the figures since the outbreak of the war of mass killing in Gaza, represent an increase of 800 percent in the number of counselors and psychologists, providing 290,000 hours of therapy in clinical units, and the participation of 8,900 people in therapeutic workshops, and 72,000 participants in community procedures.

The data also showed that 28 percent of the residents of the so-called "Gaza enclave," which houses occupation forces, are receiving psychological treatment, while the number of "Israelis" who are receiving treatment in different settings reached 34,083 people.

Al-Waie: This is what happened to the Jewish army, which fought with large numbers and sophisticated weaponry, a small group of Muslim youth. How would it fare if it faced a single army of Muslims? What if the Islamic Khilafah (Caliphate) was established and declared war on the Jews and jihad?! The Jewish entity, with a green light from America, resumes the war on Gaza

The British newspaper, "The Guardian," said in its editorial that the occupation's violation of the ceasefire agreement in Gaza is "destroying hope along with lives."

The editorial explained that the survival of prime minister of the Jewish entity, "Benjamin Netanyahu is kept in place by an endless war, at a terrible cost to Palestinians and hostages." It added that what happened on Tuesday 18 March "was one of the deadliest days since the early months of the conflict"

Commenting on the occupation state's claims that it was attacking terrorist targets, the newspaper pointed out that "health authorities in Gaza say that 174 children and 89 women were among the more than 400 dead."

It continued be explaining that "Evacuation orders issued by the military suggest that a renewed ground offensive may be on its way for traumatised and repeatedly displaced Palestinians. Benjamin Netanyahu warned that it was "only the beginning" and the military issued new evacuation orders to traumatised and repeatedly displaced Palestinians. Families of the remaining Israeli hostages are terrified and angry too, attacking the government for choosing to give up on them."

Arrests and suppression of demonstrations What is happening in Türkiye?

On 19 March, 2025, Istanbul Mayor Ekrem İmamoğlu was arrested by Turkish authorities on charges of corruption and aiding a terrorist organization. This arrest came days before his expected nomination as the Republican People's Party's (CHP) presidential candidate in the 2028 elections. İmamoğlu is a prominent opposition figure to President Recep Tayyip

Erdoğan and was expected to be nominated by the CHP for the next presidential elections in 2028.

His arrest coincided with Istanbul University's revocation of his degree, potentially barring him from running for president, as the Turkish constitution requires candidates to have a university degree. In addition to İmamoğlu, the arrests included more than 100 people, including his aides and mayors of districts in Istanbul.

These arrests sparked a wave of protests in Istanbul and other Turkish cities, with the CHP describing them as a "civilian coup" against democracy.

In response, authorities imposed a four-day ban on demonstrations and gatherings in Istanbul, while increasing security presence in the city. Access to social media platforms such as X and Instagram has also been restricted.

Al-Waie: Erdogan has ruled Turkey with secularism for more than two decades, neither supporting Islam nor Muslims, nor gaining the approval of secularists and Kemalists. If his luster fades and his energy is exhausted, he will lose the support of his colonialists masters. It's not unlikely they will depose him, as they have deposed others in other countries. They don't care about him. Therefore, Erdogan is trying to neutralize any opposition that might pose a threat to his position and influence... This is democracy at its finest!

Why is the Jewish entity repeating its raids on Syria? And what is it targeting?

The air force of the Jews intensified its raids and attacks on the Daraa region in southern Syria. An army spokesperson for the occupation stated that military sites containing weapons and military equipment belonging to the former Syrian regime were targeted, which armed groups loyal to the new regime are currently attempting to use.

The attacks targeted military sites in the Daraa countryside, weapons and ammunition depots, the 175th Regiment, military housing, and the 12th Brigade in the city of Izraa, in addition to the 15th Brigade in the city of Inkhil in the northern Daraa countryside. The raids also targeted military sites loyal to the new Syrian regime.

The attacks also targeted the 132nd Brigade of the army of the ousted president Bashar al-Assad regime, and a military site controlled by Iranian militias in the area. The raids also included sites in Al-Kiswah in the Damascus countryside, and military sites in Tal al-Manea around the city of Al-Kiswah in the Damascus countryside. To justify the airstrikes on Syria, the chief of the army of Jews asserted in a statement that "the presence of these weapons in southern Syria poses a threat to the State of "Israel," and that accordingly, the military establishment will not allow a military threat near the buffer zone and along the ceasefire line, and will act against it," according to "Israel's" Channel 13.
